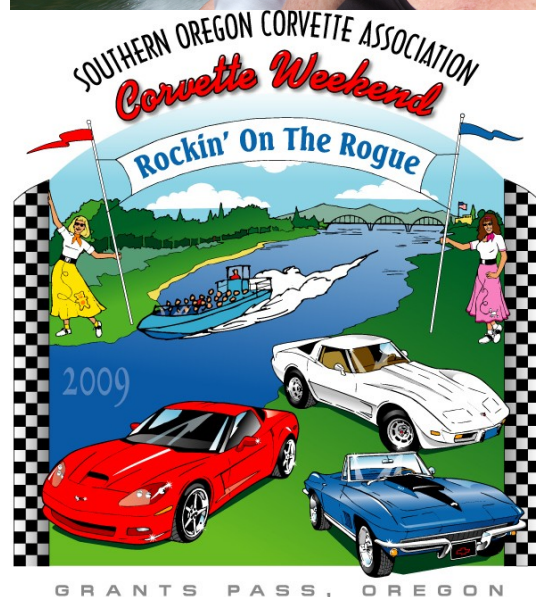
*Needless to say, it was a great time and all hated to call it a night when the Bunko was*
